

# Facebook Login Setup - Simple Membership Social Login Addon

This guide will walk you through the process of configuring your Facebook Developers account to obtain the necessary OAuth credentials (App ID and App Secret) for enabling Facebook Login in the SWPM Social Login addon.

**Important Note:** Facebook regularly updates the user interface. If some of the screenshots in this guide don't match what you see, don't worry. The core steps and concepts remain the same.


## Prerequisites

- A Facebook account.
- The **Valid OAuth Redirect URI** from your **SWPM Social Login Addon** settings page.


## Facebook Login Setup Steps

### Step 1: Create a New App

1. Navigate to the [Meta for Developers](https://developers.facebook.com) website and log in with your Facebook account. (<https://developers.facebook.com>).
2. Click on **My Apps** in the top-right corner, then select **Create App**.
3. On the next screen, give your app a **Display Name** (example: SWPM Social Login).
4. Enter a **Contact Email** address and then click **Next**.



5. On the next screen, select **“Authenticate and request data from users with Facebook Login”** and then click **Next**.



6. You will be asked whether to connect this new app to a business portfolio. If you don't have one, select **“I don't want to connect a business portfolio yet”** and click **Next**.



4. Click "**Save Changes**" to apply your settings.

### Step 3: Get Your App ID and App Secret

Finally, you can retrieve the two credentials you need. First, configure the following settings based on your web application.

1. In the left-hand menu, navigate to **Settings** → **Basic**.
2. Here you will find your **App ID** at the top of the page.
3. Next to the **App Secret** field, click the **Show** button to reveal the secret key. You may be prompted to enter your Facebook password for verification.
4. Copy both the **App ID** and the **App Secret** and paste them into the corresponding fields in your Simple Membership Social Login Addon settings page.
5. Enter your **Privacy, Privacy Policy URL, Terms of Service URL, User Data Deletion URL, Category**. These are required to make your app public.

### Step 4: Publish the App

By default, your app is in "Development Mode" and can only be used by developers on the app. To make it available to all your website visitors:

1. Once testing is complete, you can publish the app by completing business verification to make the system production-ready.

## Step 5: Copy the App ID and App Secret

1. **Facebook App ID:** Copy the full value of the **App ID**.
2. **Facebook App Secret:** Copy the full value of the **App Secret**.
3. **Paste these values** into the corresponding **Facebook App ID** and **Facebook App Secret** fields in your **SWPM Social Login Addon Settings** and save your changes.

The Facebook Login option should now be fully configured and ready to use!
